CHANGES TO SERVING AT MASS

**After discussion and taking advice Fr Philip has decided to open serving at
the altar up to both boys and girls (men and women). This means that we
will need to revise how we serve at Mass. We would like to hold a meeting
after Mass on Sunday 20th September at All Saints for ALL young people and
their families who are interested in serving or helping in church in any way.
The meeting will be accompanied by pizza and soft drinks and will be an
opportunity to hear more about these plans. PLEASE come along with young
people 11-18 and support this new start in youth work in our parish. Serving
training for all servers will be offered and Fr Philip will be involved in this
training.**

**From the 27th September whilst there will be a rota for some key serving
roles anyone who wishes to serve can come to sacristy and robe when they
come to Mass.**

SUNDAY SCHOOL – JUNIOR CHURCH
